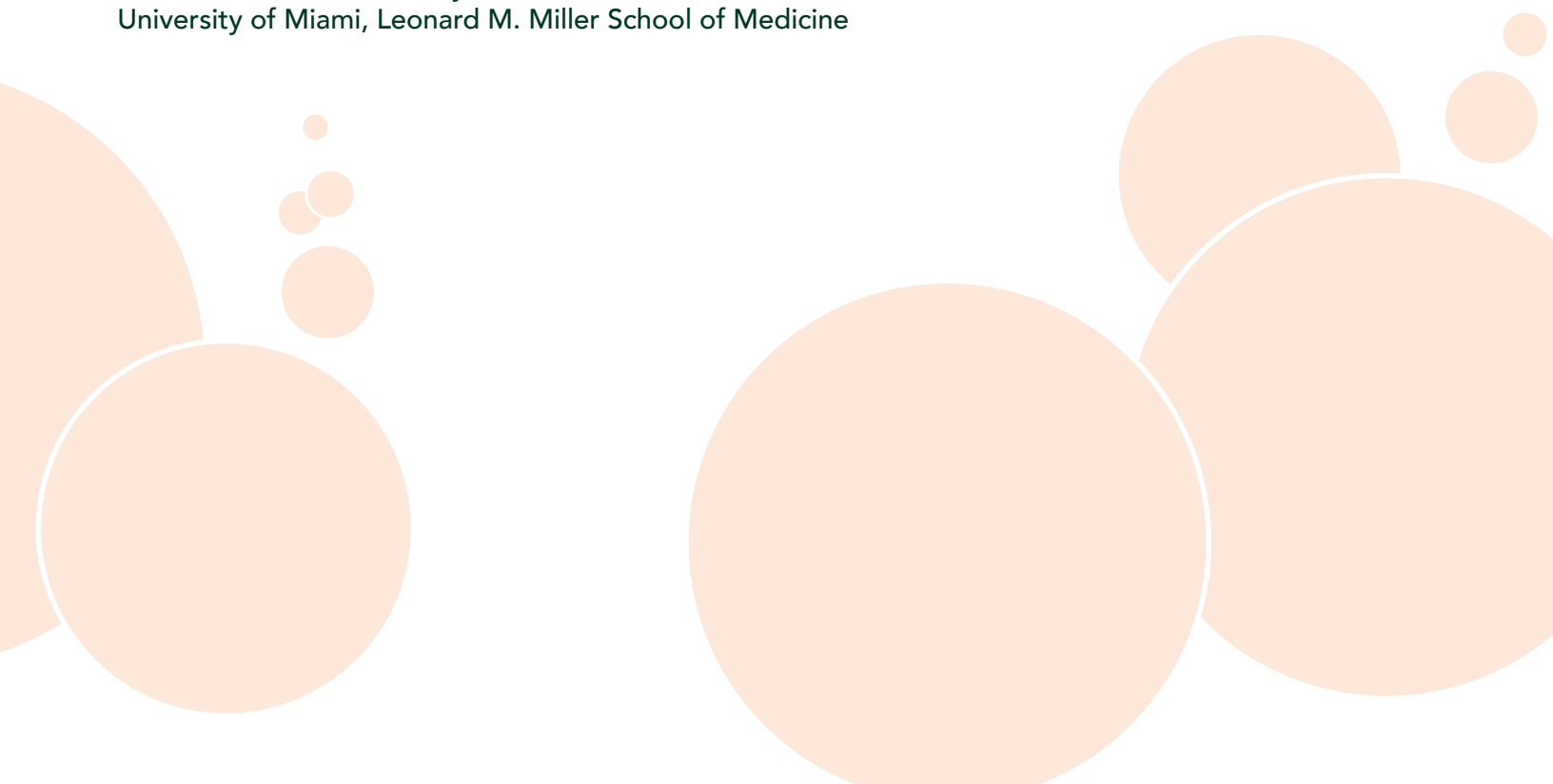

TERMS & CONDITIONS

CONFERENCE ORGANIZER

For the purposes of this document, the Miami Gastroenterology Congress, Focus Medical Communications, and Tactical Advantage Group will be referred to as the Conference Organizer.

REPORTABLE EXPENSES

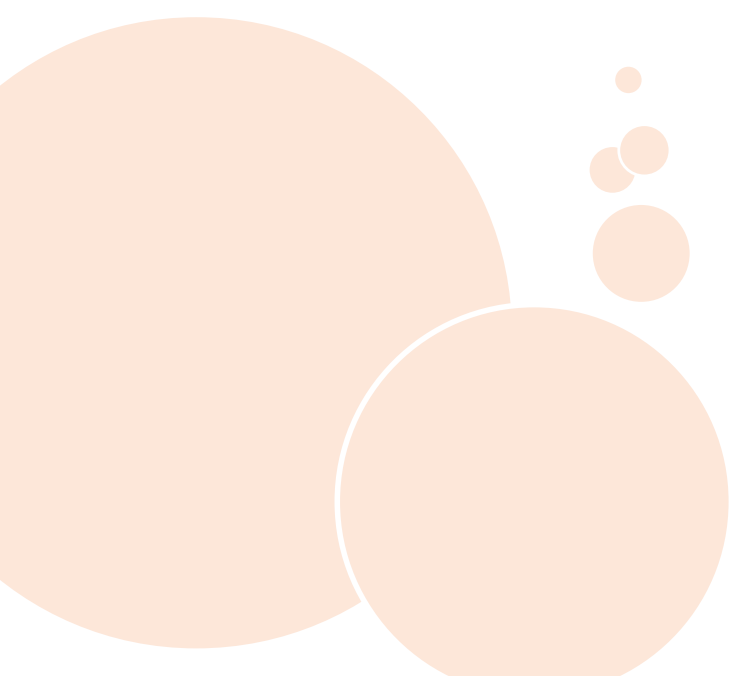

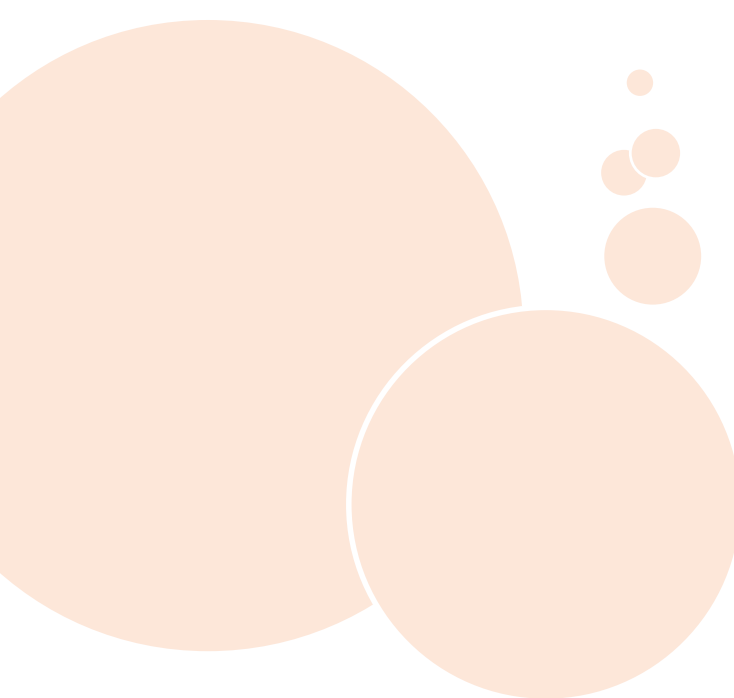
